

Wrath of 1 Thess vs. Wrath in Rev.

1 Thessalonians:

- word used - $\sigma\gamma\eta$

- meaning - a strong indignation directed at wrongdoing
with a focus on retribution

1:10 - to save us from the wrath to come

2:16 - But wrath arrived finally.

5:9 - not accustomed to us with wrath but with obtaining salvation
through our Lord Jesus Christ of the one who will die on
behalf of us, so that if we are on alert [or] if we
are sleeping [dead] then together we may live with Him.

Revelation

- word used - $\sigma\gamma\eta\varsigma$

- meaning - state of intense displeasure

- wrath, anger, rage

Revelation 5:16-11 - wrath to come - judgment of sin
